

TIPPING POINT PRAYER INITIATIVE INTRODUCTION

We at Moreleta Park Congregation believe the Lord has laid it on our hearts to commence and co-ordinate a country wide prayer movement, which we have called the “Tipping point” prayer initiative.

As the name suggests we believe our country has reached a *tipping point* spiritually, socially, politically and economically. In other words *a point beyond which we would descend very quickly* into complete anarchy, chaos and lawlessness.

Are we perhaps being a little pessimistic, melodramatic and unrealistic? We believe not.

- Ask any farmer how things are really going in the farming community
- Ask a policeman what they see, experience and live through day by day.
- Ask a school teacher what the real state of affairs is in our schools, never mind the government or less privileged schools, even in our elite schools
- Take the trouble to read each painful newspaper article day by day for the next week.

- Ask yourself honestly: can things really continue as they are, indefinitely?

No my dear friend. We are neither unrealistic nor unduly pessimistic. On the contrary, we are facing facts as they are, realistically and honestly. Truthfully: things are going badly in South Africa, in fact, the current situation is worse than at any time in our history.

BUT GOD... But God has not finished with the nation of South Africa, we have this assurance from His Word, and for this very reason we have hope for our future. As we read in the book Esther, we believe with all our heart that *God has called all the Christians in South Africa*, across all borders and color lines – especially for a time such as this. (Esther 4:14)

God has outlined clearly for us in His Word that He desires to heal our land, if we turn to Him in humility, with our whole heart - as Queen Esther and the Jews did at a time of great crisis in Jewish history. Similarly, we have determined to petition Almighty God in South Africa’s time of crisis, exactly as the Jewish nation in the time of Queen Esther.

We, Moreleta Park Congregation: Prayer Ministry (MPC Prayer) will endeavor to co-ordinate country wide prayer and petition, (with a humble and serving heart) in order to involve as many Christians as possible in the prayer process, fully believing that God will give you that for which we are longing: country wide revival, the healing of our land.

How will the prayer movement work in practice?

1. MPC will make teaching material available on a regular (1-2) weekly basis in to establish, encourage and build up prayer warriors.
2. We will also regularly place and review what we perceive to be the most important, or “tipping point” prayer items for individual or group prayer. 3. All prayer activities, country wide, will be co-ordinated and managed via the MPC website
